Slide 1:

Title of book (underlined or italicized)

Author of book

Your name
Include a graphic that accurately symbolizes the book.

Slide 2:

Setting (where and when)

Be as specific as you can (city, state, country, season, morning, noon, night, etc.)

Include a graphic that relates to the setting.

*If you don't have an exact when, use clues to take a guess. Is it in modern times? Or was it back in history?

*If the setting changes in the story, choose the one you feel is most important.

Slide 3:

Characters:

Who is the main character(s)? Who are the supporting characters?

Write a paragraph about your favorite character (5 or more sentences). Use details from the text to describe this character.

Bonus slide: Compare and contrast two characters from your book. How are they alike? How are they different? How do you know? Use details from the text.

Slide 4

Context Clues

As you read, write down at least 5 words you don't know, or think are interesting.

Using context clues write what you think the words might mean. When you are done, use a dictionary to look up what the word actually means.

Share 3 of your most favorite words on this slide.

Figurative Language Finder

Find 3 examples of either a simile, metaphor, and/ or hyperbole. Write down each sentence containing the example of the figurative language.

Label each of the 3 sentences with S (simile), M (metaphor) or H (hyperbole)

Slide 6

Summarize as you read (first ½ of the book)
What happened in the *beginning* of the book? What is the main idea? Use details from the text to support your summary.

Slide 7

Summarize as you read (the second ⅓ of the book)
What happened in the *middle* of the book? What is the main idea? Use details from the text to support your summary.

Slide 8

Summarize the ending

What happened at the *end* of the book? What is the main idea? Use details from the text to support your summary.
